Julita Manor & gardens

Julita Manor is located 25 km outside Katrineholm in beautiful Sörmland. Since 1941 the manor has been part of the Nordic Museum, one of Sweden's largest cultural history museums.

Nordic Museum's castles and manors

Julita Manor & Gardens offers a lot to see and discover for people of all ages. Walk around the park and gardens, enjoy a coffee break by the lake, browse and buy in the museum shop, join a guided tour and experience exhibitions and events. Julita Manor is an example of how a large estate would have looked and operated in the early 20th century. The last private owner, Arthur Bäckström who donated the estate to Nordiska museet in 1941, lived in the Manor House, which is open to visitors by guided tours. Several other buildings can be visited independently. The estate also includes 2,000 hectares of land and a park with a kitchen garden, orchard, hop garden and presentation garden. The orchard has approximately 290 fruit trees, and the living collections include hops, geraniums and peonies. The exhibitions at Julita Manor tell of the estate's horticultural history and about the legacy of the last private owner.

Our unique cellar includes champagne bottles dating from 1907, salvaged from the Jönköping shipwreck. The bottles lay on the seabed for over 80 years and need to be preserved in the same way. So we've rebuilt our wine cellar to allow us to both serve and display around 100 of these unique bottles. Instead of walls in our wine cellar we have aquariums, where the champagne is kept in water, just as it has been since 1916.

Öster Malma Castle

Our history begins as early as the 16th century but it was when Anna Maria Silfverstierna, married to Wilhelm Drakenhielm, inherited Öster Malma that the castle we can see today was built - today one of the best preserved baroque castles in Sweden. Thanks to the Swedish Hunters' Association's chairman HRH Prince Gustaf Adolf, who acted in 1947 we can soon celebrate 80 years at Öster Malma. And the castle ghost then? Sure, every now and then (usually at night) a veiled being sweeps through the halls.

Besides the beautiful castle you can now walk through the historic park and terraces and enjoy the evening sun.

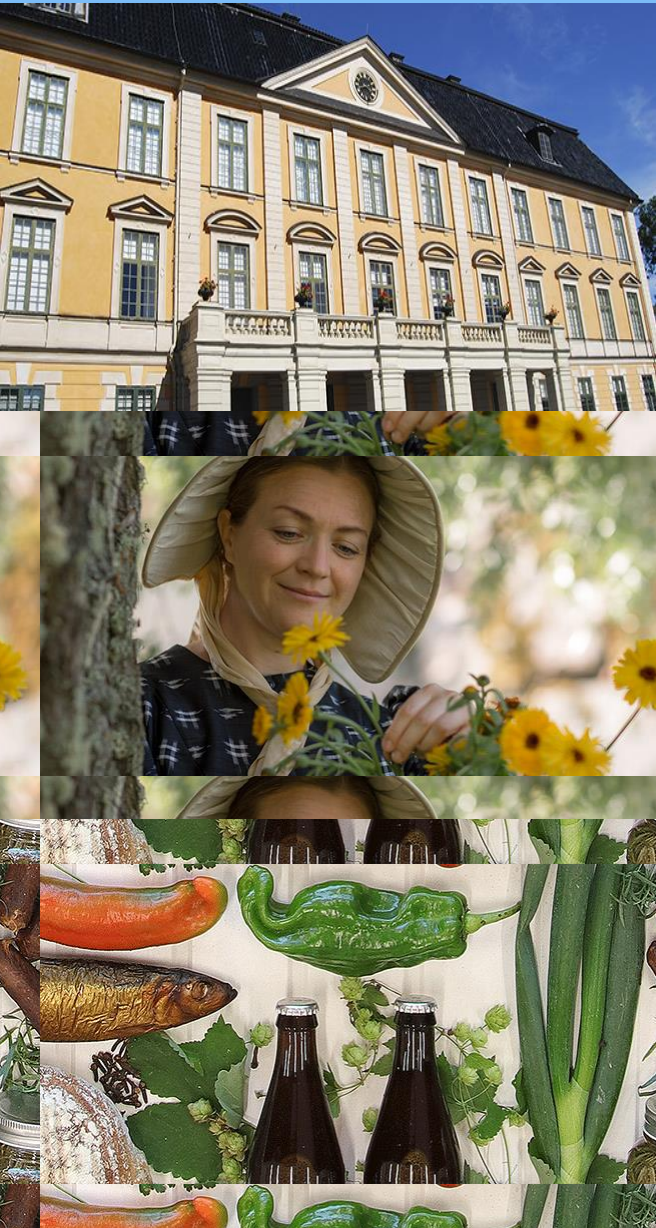

Nynäs Manor: A glimpse into the past

Come with us to one of Sörmlands best-preserved castles and hear the whispers from centuries past. Come closer. Listen carefully and you'll almost hear the clang of pots and pans as the servants prepare the evening meal. What do you think the family of the estate would be having for dinner?

The first mention in writing of this beautiful estate was in a letter from 1328. But discoveries and graves from the bronze and iron age indicate that people flourished on these lands long before then. Sundbyholm Castle

Sundbyholm Castle is situated on the glimmering shores of Lake Malaren, surrounded by a long sand beach, a prize-awarded marina, a castle park and fairytale forests. The Castle was built by the Admiral of the Navy Carl Carlsson Gyllenhielm, the son of King Karl IX. Today, the Castle contains a reputable restaurant and banquet halls.

Adjacent to the castle are 115 modern hotel rooms and suites in different categories, from smaller double rooms to standard double rooms and from family suites to luxurious manor suites. Breakfast and dinner is served in the castle. Nearby is the famous 1000-year old rune stone 'Sigurd' and a horse racing track. Summertime, there are log-rafts, canoes and bikes for hire and during winter guests can relax in the saunas or in the hot spa's outdoors. The resort is eco-labelled with Green Key.

Energizing shortbreak at the castle

Get away for a shortbreak and enjoy the fantastic surroundings of Sundbyholm Castle. We recommend that you start your stay with a Swedish fika that we can wrap up in case you want to enjoy it out in our beautiful nature, maybe in a canoe, on a bike or in Europe's northernmost beech forest located around the corner.

During the day you can explore this magical location and in the evening you can enjoy a table-served candle-light dinner at the castle. After a good night's sleep in our eco-labelled beds you will wake up to an atmospheric breakfast in the castle.
